Brite 'N' White Liquid Bleach

DESCRIPTION

Brite 'N White is a liquid sodium hypochlorite bleach that can be used for cleaning, whitening, removing stains, sanitising and deodorising.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- **Laundry:** Colour-Fast: cottons and linens, orlan, nylon, dacron and terylene. Contains detergents to lower the surface tension of water and emulsify soils to aid in their removal.
- **Stain Removal:** ink, egg, milk, coffee, tea, chocolate, wine, blood, scorch, grass, fruit, vegetable, collar dirt and mildew.
- **Kitchen:** benches, drains, cutting boards, dishmops, stoves, refrigerators, dishwashers, crockery, glassware and plasticware.
- **Bathroom:** shower recess, bath, basin, tiles, grouting, floor, mildew, brushes and combs.
- **Toilets:** removes stains, sanitises and deodorise both the toilet bowls and seats.
- **The Building:** unpainted woodwork, linoleum, plastic garbage bins, drains, concrete stains.
- **Colour coded labelling**
Ensures easy product identification and simplifies training

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LAUNDRY:

Household Machines

Top Loading	1 cup per load
Front Loading	½ cup per load
Twin Tub	¼ cup per load

Commercial Machines

50-60ml (¼ cup) **Brite 'N White** per 10 litres of water.

Colour-Fast Test:

Mix 1/3 cup **Brite 'N White** with 2/3 cup of water, then test one drop of this solution on an inconspicuous portion of the fabric. Make sure drop penetrates, let stand 2 minutes and blot dry.

Stain Removal:

½ cup **Brite 'N White** per 2 litres of cold water for 5 minutes. Rinse well and repeat soaking if necessary.

KITCHEN:

Wash clean first, then wipe with a cloth dipped in a solution of ¼ cup **Brite 'N White** per 1 litre of warm water. Leave the surface wet for 5 minutes and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

Stained kitchenware articles that are small enough for soaking are best treated in this matter. Make up a bath using ¼ cup of **Brite 'N White** to 2 litres of water. Allow articles to soak for up to 15 minutes; rinse and dry.

TOILETS:

Wash toilet seat with cloth or sponge in 1/4 cup **Brite 'N White** mixed with 1 litre of water.

THE BUILDING:

Wash then wipe with a cloth dipped into a solution of ¼ cup **Brite 'N White** per 1 litre of warm water. Leave the surface wet for 5 minutes and wipe dry with a clean cloth. Operators should wash hands immediately after use.

IMPORTANT:

- Do not use ammonia or acid based toilet bowl cleaners with **Brite 'N White**.
- Do not use on silk, wool, leather, everglaze, rayon, acetate, drip dry and non-iron cottons.
- Do not use on aluminium, chipped or worn enamel, silver, steel or any unpainted metal surface.
- Dilute **Brite 'N White** with water before immersing any articles. Do not use undiluted at any time.
- Ensure lid is tight and store in a cool place.
