BLEACH

Multi-purpose bleach with many applications in the laundry, kitchen and bathroom.

FEATURES

- Chesser Bleach is a liquid chlorinated bleach. Chlorine is a very powerful bleach capable of removing many stubborn stains.
- Bleach has many uses. It can be used in the laundry to remove stains from white linen, in the bathroom to kill mould and mildew, and in the kitchen for destaining tea and coffee cups, chopping boards, etc.
- Bleach is a powerful disinfectant as well as a bleaching agent.

HOW & WHERE TO USE

- In the laundry add 1/2 to 1 cup of Bleach to 1 litre of water, then add to the wash. Do not pour directly onto clothes. Only use on white fabrics.
- For bleaching stubborn stains soak in a bucket containing 1/2 cup in 2.5 litres cold water. Soak for 5 minutes, then rinse well.
- For kitchen, bathroom and laundry surfaces for killing and bleaching mould and mildew, use at a rate of 1:20 (1/2 cup in 2.5 litres of water).
- Always read washing instructions to see if Bleach can be used. Never use on wool, silk, leather, rayon or acetate.
- Do not mix it with any other chemicals unless directed.
- If using manually, do not use in hot water to avoid chlorine fumes being given off.
