TRI KLEEN

DISSOLVES GREASE & FAT

Tri Kleen is a granular white powder detergent with many uses. It is a heavy duty alkaline cleaner for cleaning fats, grease and other soils off floors, walls and equipment. It can also be used as a break wash and alkaline builder in commercial laundries. It is ideal for removing fat & grease build up on floors and concrete in meat works.

FEATURES

- Tri Kleen is a strongly alkaline cleaner containing anionic and non ionic surfactants. It effectively removes heavy grease and fat deposits with minimum effort.
- Tri Kleen is a very versatile product. It can be used for cleaning floors, equipment, and also used in the laundry.
- Tri Kleen is a strong cleaner, but is **non caustic** It can be used to replace caustic containing cleaners making the process much safer.

HOW & WHERE TO USE

- For concrete floors Tri Kleen can be used in two different ways. Either make up in a bucket adding $\frac{1}{4}$ cup for normal cleaning or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup for heavy soils. Use warm water for best results. Wet floors, sprinkle over Tri Kleen and scrub in using a stiff brush or scrubbing machine. Then rinse off with plenty of water. For vinyl floors and cleaning equipment and surfaces use in a bucket containing $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ cup in warm water. Always wear rubber gloves if using with the hands.
- Tri Kleen is suitable for cleaning deep fryers. Drain out oil and fill with water. Add about 1 cup of Tri Kleen per 25 litre capacity and heat till near boiling. Stir whilst heating till Tri Kleen is dissolved. Leave to soak a few hours, then drain and rinse with plenty of water. Dry and refill with oil.

- Tri Kleen can also be used to soak heavily soiled items such as butcher's coats, chef's jackets and soiled table linen. Soak in a trough containing from $\frac{1}{4}$ to 1 cup, then wash in the normal manner.
- As a break wash in commercial laundries use 1-2 cups per 25Kg capacity.
