DESCRIPTION

ATTAC toilet bowl cleaner is a viscous buffered, acid cleaner formulated for every day maintenance of toilets and urinals. **ATTAC** also contains a Green Apple fragrance to leave a pleasant after odour. **ATTAC** with added viscosity gives greater cling to toilet bowls and urinals allowing longer contact for better cleaning. **ATTAC** is suitable as a cleaner of stainless steel, copper, brass and porcelain with excellent removal of calcium scale and deposits, urine stains, encrustations and rust, iron and copper stains (verdigris). In fact **ATTAC** provides thorough sanitary cleaning, deodourising and reodourising in one operation

USE

TOILET BOWLS

Squirt a direct stream of **ATTAC** under the toilet bowl rim and around the inside wall including outlet pipe and seat. Swab or scrub the solution with mop applicator or toilet brush and then flush the bowl and wipe the seat clean.

URINALS & WASH BASINS

Squirt a direct stream of **ATTAC** along the urinal. Swab or scrub with a mop applicator or brush and then flush. Repeat daily. In cases of extreme dirt or stubborn stains, allow **ATTAC 2 – 3 MINUTES CONTACT BEFORE FLUSHING**.

NOTE:

If used on stainless steel, immediately flush thoroughly and profusely with water.

CAUTION: ATTAC is an acid cleaner – Sulphuric Acid 4% - Phosphoric Acid 1%.

Always wear rubber gloves and adequate protective clothing.

SAFETY

First Aid

Eyes: If splashed in eyes, flush with water for 15 min. Seek medical advice.

Skin: Wash affected area with soap and water.

Inhalation: If mists are inhaled, remove patient to fresh air. Seek medical advice.

Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Give milk or water to dilute. Seek medical advice.
